THIS WORKSHOP IS WERE STAKEHOLDERS UNDERSTAND EACH OTHERS ROLE AND KNOW WHAT THEY ARE REQUIRED TO DO WHENEVER THERE IS AN ENVIRONMENT AND SOCIAL ISSUE THAT CAN POTENTIALLY AFFECT THE PROGRAM.
