2. Road Infrastructure Development Project Progress

SC was updated on the 2nd projects currently being MCA-V Road infrastructure Development Projects progress for the two projects, Efate Ring Road and the Santo East Coast Road. The report stated that there is sufficient funding to cover both project with some cost variations.

Discussions:

The SC members noted and accepted the report presented hoverer, issues were also raised to seek further clarifications on the potential costs implications for contracts and the associated liabilities related to the proposed amendments to sub-clauses 4.13, 4.14 and 4.18 as per the Particular Conditions of the Design and Build Contract. SC noted that a lot of effort is required through the whole of Government approach in order to improve the current score cards ratings.
