Subject: Agreement Between Millennium Challenge Account-Vanuatu ("MCA") and the Ministry of Agriculture, Quarantine, Forestry and Fisheries ("MAQFF) Regarding Cooperation to Implement the Transport Infrastructure Project under the Vanuatu Millennium Challenge Compact.

This letter sets forth our agreement regarding the services that the Ministry of Agriculture, Quarantine, Forestry and Fisheries("MAQFF") will provide, and the funds that MCA-Vanuatu ("MCA") will allocate to MAQFF to facilitate the performance of these services in a manner consistent with MCA's priorities and timelines. This agreement is subject to the terms of the Millennium Challenge Compact between the United States of America acting through the Millennium Challenge Corporation and the Government of the Republic of Vanuatu ("the Compact"). Under the Compact, the Government of Vanuatu has undertaken certain roles and responsibilities on behalf of all Government agencies, and has assigned the coordination of these roles and responsibilities to MCA.

MAQFF and MCA have the mutual objective to work cooperatively and communicate regularly to implement the Compact in a timely and cost-effective manner, with due diligence, efficiency, and professionalism.

Under the direction of the Director General, MAQFF will undertake at a higher rate and more compressed time frame, to help implement the Resettlement Action Plans for Efate Ring Road and Santo East Coast Road under the Transport Infrastructure Project

The required services, which are further described in Annex 1 of this letter. will include:

- Assist in the implementation of MCA Resettlement Action Plans for Efate Ring Road and Santo East Coast Road
- Expeditious provision of seeds or seedlings as entitlements for the replacement of significant trees such as fruit trees and commercial trees and cash crops

It is noted by both parties that the provision of seeds or seedlings (goodwill entitlements) under the Resettlement Action Plans must be completed as soon as possible and no later than September 30, 2010. Determination for the provision of seedlings is provided in Annex III of the agreement.

MCA will undertake, under the direction of the MCA Program Director and with the support of the Environmental and Social Impact Officers to provide timely information and updates on MCA's priorities and timelines, and to allocate funds to MAQFF to cover incremental travel costs and related incidental expenses, beyond those expected in the normal course of MAQFF operations, to perform the services required under this agreement. MCA's responsibilities under this agreement are described in Annex II, which includes templates for the approval and disbursement of funds. All claims for funds under this agreement must be made prior to December 2010.

This agreement shall cease on 28 April 2011.

ANNEX I

MINISTRY OF AGRICULTURE, QUARANTINE, FORESTRY AND FISHERIES RESPONSIBILITIES

The Ministry of Agriculture, Quarantine, Forestry and Fisheries will provide, through the Director of Agriculture; the Director of Quarantine, the Director of Forestry, Director of Fisheries, the following services under this agreement related to the Transport Infrastructure Project:

- Respond to MCA's updated priorities and schedules for distribution of seedling entitlements to Project Affected Persons (PAP). The proposed schedule is attached in Annex III.
 - Attached to this agreement in Annex IV is a list of actual losses of trees and crops that require replacements by way of seedlings. The list may be updated from time to time by MCA and provided to line departments concerned.
- 2. Provide assistance to the MCA Environment and Social Impact Officers to implement the ERR and SECR Resettlement Action Plans, particularly the Inventory of Losses Table.
- Raising and supplying of seedlings as entitlements for the replacement of significant trees such as fruit trees and commercial trees and cash crops
- 4. Provide coordinated access to MAQFF line department and work cooperatively with MCA and its implementing entities and contractors to implement the Resettlement Action Plan (RAP), including by using its existing working relationships and processes with other relevant agencies and groups such as the provincial governments and landowners.

ANNEX II MCA RESPONSIBILITIES

MCA will perform the following actions under this agreement relating to the Transport Infrastructure Project:

- 1. Provide MAQFF with copies of ERR and SECR Resettlement Action Plans.
- 2. Deliver to MAQFF and line departments, copies of relevant documents related to the Compact and its implementation.
- 3. Provide MAQFF and line departments with timely updates on overall project progress, priorities and timelines, including environmental matters, and other information as necessary to perform the services described in this agreement. Define the geographic scope of the MCA "project areas", regarding areas for the distribution of seedlings
- 4. Provide support through its staff and implementing entities such as ESU to compare pertinent data, including surveys and leases, to identify MAQFF issues and possible solutions which impact on the Compact program.
- 5. Provide support in relation to the environmental and social impact tasks, particularly in relation to resettlement, in this agreement through the services of the MCA Environmental and Social Impact Officers; act to meet Vanuatu environmental and social law and MAQFF line departments' approval processes; and require MCA's implementing entities and contractors also to comply.
- 6. Allocate up to US\$8000 to finance local travel expenses related to this agreement and ensure the prompt approval and payment for approved expenses for which appropriate supporting documentation using the MCA Domestic Travel Allowance Form (see below) is submitted to MCA. The form should be submitted for each individual traveller and should include information on airline ticket quotes and a breakdown of accommodation and per diem expenses. Once all necessary approvals of the Requisition Request form (see below) and LPOs have been obtained, the Fiscal Agent will issue payment of airline expenses and accountable imprests for accommodation and per diem before travel commences.
- 7. Provide in-kind support, for example, photocopy paper, and review the need for additional budget allocations for travel related expenses if required.
