### **Santo Planned Work**

Pavement construction has reached the 30 km peg and will continue progressing North of Velit Bay. Clearing will progress to towards the new Loreloraseri Quarry at the 34 km peg.

#### **Efate Planned Work**

Clearing and widening work will progress towards Pangpang. Side drains and pavement will be constructed between Epau and Elu. Pavement overlay will continue between Epau Village and Vatgate.

#### **Bigrod Sefti Posta Kompetisen**

Details of the "Bigrod Sefti Posta Kompetisen" have been advertised. Paper, crayons and coloured pencils to make the posters have been distributed to the villages on Santo and Efate associated with the road (although entrants can use other materials, apart from those distributed, if they want to).

Separate competitions are being held on Santo and Efate and the winners will be announced at the Handback Ceremonies being held on Santo (3 February) and Efate (4 February). The closing date for entries is 28 January.

## **Damage To New Signs**

We are disappointed to see that some of the recently installed signs have been damaged by having stones thrown at them. This is happening on both Efate and Santo. Apart from being an offence under the

Road Traffic Act this also reflects badly on the village or location where the signs are installed. Local residents are requested to be vigilant and report offenders to the Police.

## **Traffic Cautions**

Traffic flows on Klehm's Hill will continue to be restricted to one lane while the guardrail and concrete pavement is constructed. There will also be some total road closures of up to 30 minutes while the concrete trucks discharge.
